You can buy a hard copy of the book in Veritas or similar religious bookshops or download it from the internet if you prefer or even purchase an App such as Universalis.

This week, we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Lent with only three weeks to go until Easter. Today's Gospel reading is from the Gospel of St. John and gives us the very powerful image of Jesus being lifted up on the Cross, so that our sins can be forgiven. This really encapsulates the gift to us all of Easter as we come to more fully understand the mystery of Christ's death and resurrection.

Our reading today echoes the very beginning of John's Gospel where he says: *"God loved the world so much that he gave us his only son, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life."*

By God's grace, we are people of the resurrection, we are an Easter people, joyfully proclaiming our salvation through the death and resurrection of Jesus. Over the next three weeks, the Church asks us to be patient and prayerful as we await the celebration of the Easter Triduum. So, let us pray and reflect this weekend on the sacrifice of Jesus for us all on the Cross as we look forward to the great feast of Easter. And let us thank him for the great offering of himself in love for us all. As the prayer at Mass says:

*"Lord by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free, you are the saviour of the world."*
