John Flaherty is a native Dubliner and grew up in the parishes of the Pro-Cathedral and Fairview. He is the eldest of a family of seven children. Schooldays were spent in the Central Model Infants School, St. Columba's C.B.S., Strand Street, St. Joseph's C.B.S. Fairview, with further studies at U.C.D. (B.A.), and Holy Cross College, Clonliffe, (B.D.). He was Ordained Priest for the Archdiocese of Dublin in June 1982 in the Pro-Cathedral by Archbishop Dermot Ryan. He served as Chaplain to Ballymun Comprehensive Schools, Priest-Teacher Killester V.E.C., Priest-Teacher Colaiste Lorcaín, Castledermot and as Chaplain to the De La Salle Brothers, Beneavin, Holy Faith Sisters, Killester and the Parishes of St. Benedict, Grange Park Raheny
