inspiration from Mary, Mother of Evangelization. Moved by the Spirit, she welcomed the Word of life in the depths of her humble faith. May the Virgin Mother help us to say our own "yes", conscious of the urgent need to make the Good News of Jesus resound in our time."

Of course, people will tell you that the great missions today are much closer to home. Ironically, at a time when the Church is growing substantially in Africa and Asia, where so many of our missionaries went to work, the Church at home is not as vibrant as it once was.

We can help missionaries in many ways both by our prayers and by assisting the different missionary orders financially when we can afford to do so, perhaps by buying a magazine or supporting a collection.

Pope Francis says: "The mandate of the Gospel to "go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Mt 28:19-20) has not ceased; rather this command commits all of us, in the current landscape with all its challenges, to hear the call to a renewed missionary "impulse".

"Each Christian and every community must discern the path that the Lord points out, but all of us are asked to obey his call to go forth from our own comfort zone in order to reach all the 'peripheries' in need of the light of the Gospel".

Let us pray this weekend for all missionaries whose vocation it is to spread the Gospel far from home. May we be inspired by their example of selfless service and hard work. And let is also reflect on the example of their lives as we try our best to support their work and spread the Gospel in our own parish community. *Gerard Reilly - Permanent Deacon in Donaghmede and Ayrfield parishes*

### "Mission at the Heart of the Christian Faith"

The theme for World Mission Sunday today, is 'Mission at the Heart of the Christian Faith'. It may surprise you to learn that there are almost 1,200 Irish missionaries serving throughout the world today.

Pope Francis reminds us that "World Mission Day gathers us around the person of Jesus, the very first and greatest evangelizer, who continually sends us forth to proclaim the Gospel of the love of God the Father in the power of the Holy Spirit."

I can certainly recall as child meeting various nuns and priests that were "home from the missions" for their holidays which might only have been once every three years or so. I was always very impressed by their faith and commitment as well as their dedication to the third world countries where they worked. Also, in hindsight, they

came over as happy, contented and fulfilled in their missionary work despite the sacrifices they had to make.

We had a family friend who worked as a Spiritan missionary in Sierra Leone for 26 years and, on his visits home, he would tell us stories about travelling around to the various out stations of his vast parish on a motor bike or a

pick-up truck and the work he did building schools and hospitals often assisting the workers with his own hands. He trained local catechists and sent them to the villages and towns. He built churches in many towns as well as schools and the hospital. Unfortunately, there was a serious armed conflict in Sierra Leone in the 1990s and he was caught up in an ambush and was killed along with a number of other people while trying to evacuate a hospital. Pope Francis tells us that: "in carrying out our mission, let us draw
