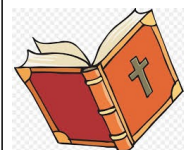

We received a total 355 sharing's across the 4 question. Q1: When you think about your experience of Church, what brings joy?

- Sense of community and support within the Church; The

choir and music brings an uplifting feeling and enhances the worship of Sunday Eucharist; Community being together; Mass, Eucharist; Praying; Music; Liturgy; Sacraments; Seeing Children being baptized; First Communion; Our beautiful Church; Coming together as a community; Liturgies, especially on special occasions such as Easter and Christmas; All experiences of joy involve Faith shared with other people; The joy of the words in prayers and the joy of attending Mass; I find joy in the sacraments especially baptism, holy communion, marriage; Attending the Mass with other people like relations and friends is particularly joyful; Joy is when we listen and share each others views; It gives me a lift; I like to be part of a community who believes in Jesus; Jesus is my Shepherd and I need him to guide me;

- My joy is having been chosen to be a member of the Church of God here in Dublin; Real joy comes from enthusiasm and satisfaction hearing the word of God; Drawn to the Church for its calming effect on my

life; Comfort in belonging to a group of people who believe in Jesus; Relationship with God is nourished; The sacraments, the joy of baptism, receiving first Holy Communion, the first day of a lifetime; Confirmation, gifts of the Spirit, courage, the joy of marriage, entering a covenant; Finding the joy in the gathering of like-minded people united in heart and mind; Working together towards the same goal; The Church is like a support system for us all, particularly when taking part in Mass; The witness of people and places; Access and support to the love of God; Speaking on behalf of the suffering and the silent majority; My Faith gives me a firm "Life" foundation, has helped me during the stressful times particularly; Prayer and my relationship with God is so important to me; Having likeminded friends who practice their Faith makes me feel comfortable and safe; Opportunity to give dedicated time to God and nourish my Faith;

- Being with likeminded people and feeling a sense of belonging and community with God centered people; Part of community of like-minded people; Feeling of not being alone; Meeting of Christ at Mass and in people whom we meet; Availability of Parish Priest; Unified Church; Community, sense of belonging, going to confession, receiving Communion, listening to the choir; First Mass attendance after Covid, confession, sense of family, Eucharist, children's choir; Community of believers; Eucharist, sacraments, good homily; Sense of community; Belonging as part of Church community; Getting involved; Meeting people of all ages through the Church; Choir, funeral ministry team in support to the bereaved; I would like the Church to be more open-minded and inclusive on its teaching on sexuality; Sharing Mass again since Covid; Meeting other people; Returning to the Choir; The joy of coming back to Church to receive the Eucharist; The joy of meeting people in the parish through volunteering to sanitize; The joy of living the gospel with a community together; The joy of welcome received, like in a family;

- Kindness and support; music; Sense of belonging; Warmth of the clergy; Humanitarian behavior of the Church e.g. Fr. Peter McVerry; Music add so much community to Church celebrations e.g. baptism, weddings; Being part of the community is a great joy and support; The dedication and service and great generosity of parish members is inspiring life giving; We receive joy when we receive the Eucharist and when music is heard it enhances the Mass; What gives me joy is meeting people through the different ministries I am involved in or just going to Mass; Daily ritual and ceremony; Shared Faith, community and Eucharist; Joy is receiving the Eucharist; Events in the Church such as marriages, Easter; Social gatherings at the Church;

- The joy of community and family; The choir adds joy in our hearts and gives us a real sense of happiness; Gods word; The joy of gathering as a family on

Sunday at Mass; The joy of Christmas Mass with your own family, young and old. The joy of Easter service; That there is hope; Connecting with other like-minded people at Mass in prayerful communion; Listening to the Gospel and readings; Sessions arranged by the Adult Faith Group; Pope Francis Community of Faith; Sunday tradition, Faith family, choir and praying; Sense of community, music, prayer (*brings comfort and hope*); Support of parish groups and Priests; Gathering and praying together; Sharing Faith experiences; Music lifts my soul; Sense of community; Community Spirit within the Church; Kindness of people to each other; Involvement of the clergy with the parish;
